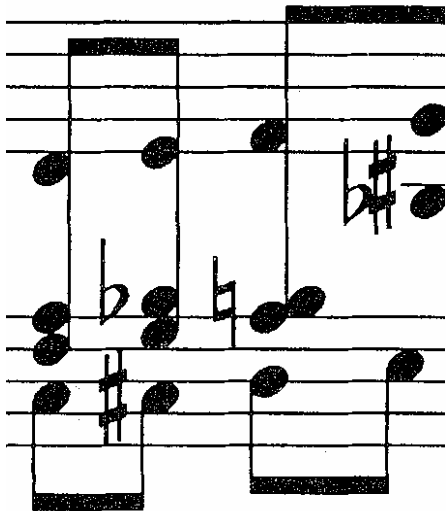


Music at your wedding...

- Whether you would like the choir to help out



Things to remember...

- This is a Christian act of worship
- It will be accompanied by Organ/Piano
- The minister doesn't like singing solos
- These should be choices that both of you make
- It's worth checking all the words before deciding on a hymn/song
- It's worth avoiding **Jerusalem, I Vow To Thee My Country** and **Lord Of The Dance**
- Copyright implications
